## White Hills Anorthosite – Bulk Sample Project Description

## Applicant 5051318 Ontario Corp. - Summary of Proposed Project

- The Bulk Sampling Project intends to acquire up to 1000 metric tonnes of Anorthosite Aggregate for testing by prospective customers. Some sample will be direct shipped and some will be trucked to the Marmora Mill of Coloured Aggerates for processing prior to shipping to potential buyers
- Site Plan maps and location information is indicated on the Activity Details Report
- The estimated start and completion date is indicated on the Activity Details Report
- The site will be access from an existing public road locally known as the "Bunny Trail: which runs southerly off of Highway 520 at Tiny Village. Access will follow an existing logging road easterly for 3.8 km then continue east via an existing trail for 2.8 km to the bulk sample site. The existing trail will be upgraded to allow wheel and track vehicle access.
- There is no historical resource extraction activity at this site
- There is no history of disturbance other than prospecting and sampling
- Currently the site is bush and rock outcrop
- There are no additional studies other that geological reports. The Crown Land Use Policy Atlas classifies this area as General Use Are (G-359). Aggregate extraction is a permitted use. The area south of Snakeskin Lake and south of the sample is listed as SHAWANAGA LAKE CONSERVATION RESERVE. The bulk sample proposal is outside of the Conservation Reserve.
