In accordance with Section 139(1)(e) of the Environmental Protection Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. E. 19 (Environmental Protection Act), I hereby give notice that, under s. 20.3 of Part II.1 of the Act, I have revoked Approval No. A120135 issued on February 12, 2023 for a waste disposal site (processing and transfer) for the receipt, temporary storage and processing of liquid industrial and hazardous waste classes 111-114, 121-123, 131-135, 145-150, 211-213, 221, 222, 231-233, 241, 251-254, 261-267, 268, 270, 282 and 331, as described in Appendix C of the Ministry document entitled "Registration Guidance Manual for Generators of Liquid Industrial and Hazardous Waste" (i.e. the Ontario Waste Classes list) updated January 2016.

The reason(s) for the revocation of the Approval is (are) as follows:

- 1. Due to the 2023 fire event at the Site, Ssnoix Products 2010 Inc. has requested in a letter dated June 19, 2025 to revoke the Site Environmental Compliance Approval and has removed all of the waste and decommissioned waste processing infrastructure at the Site; and
- 2. It is in the public interest to revoke the Environmental Compliance Approval for a waste disposal Site under these circumstances.

In accordance with Section 139 of the *Environmental Protection Act*, you may by written notice served upon me and the Ontario Land Tribunal within 15 days after receipt of this notice, require a hearing by the Tribunal. Section 142 of the *Environmental Protection Act* provides that the notice requiring the hearing ("the Notice") shall state:

a. The grounds on which you intend to rely at the hearing considering your appeal.

The Notice should also include:

- 1. The name of the appellant;
- 2. The address of the appellant;
- 3. The environmental compliance approval number;
- 4. The date of the environmental compliance approval;
- 5. The name of the Director, and;
- 6. The municipality or municipalities within which the project is to be engaged in.

And the Notice should be signed and dated by the appellant.
