You are hereby notified that I have amended Approval No. 0061-BT9KFE issued on September 16, 2020 for an aggregate extraction and processing facility , as follows:

The following definition is revoked:

"Acoustic Assessment Report" means the report, prepared in accordance with Publication NPC-233 submitted in support of the application, that documents all sources of noise emissions and Noise Control Measures present at the Facility. "Acoustic Assessment Report" also means the Acoustic Assessment Report dated June 24, 2020 and signed by Carolyn Ropp and Kana Ganesh, WSP Canada Inc.;

and replaced with the following definition:

"Acoustic Assessment Report" means the report, prepared in accordance with Publication NPC-233 and Appendix A of the Basic Comprehensive User Guide, prepared by Sammie Chan and Kana Ganesh, WSP Canada Inc. and dated March 12, 2026, submitted in support of the application, that documents all sources of noise emissions and Noise Control Measures present at the Facility, as updated in accordance with Condition 5 of this Approval;

The following conditions are revoked:

4. PERFORMANCE LIMITS

3. The Company shall:

- b. implement by not later than February 28, 2026, the Noise Control Measures as detailed and outlined in Sections 5.4.2.2, 6.1 and 6.2; Figure 6; and Appendix F of the Acoustic Assessment Report;

and replaced with the following conditions:

4. PERFORMANCE LIMITS

3. The Company shall:

- b. implement the Noise Control Measures as detailed and outlined in Sections 5.5.2.1, 6.2, 6.3; Figure 6; of the Acoustic Assessment Report dated March 12, 2026;

The following conditions are revoked:

12. UPDATED ACOUSTIC ASSESSMENT REPORT

1. The Company shall submit, not later than twelve (12) months from the date of this Approval, an updated Acoustic Assessment Report prepared by an Acoustical Consultant, to the District Manager and the Director, for approval by the Director. The updated Acoustic Assessment Report shall incorporate a Revised Noise Abatement Action Plan including:
 - a. a detailed description of the proposed Noise Control Measures, including individual acoustical performance specifications such as octave band insertion and transmission losses and barrier dimensions, to reduce the noise emissions from the Facility to comply with the limits set out in Ministry Publication NPC-300; and
 - b. a detailed timetable for implementation of the Noise Control Measures.

The following conditions are revoked:

13. ACOUSTIC AUDIT

1. The Company shall carry out Acoustic Audit measurements on the actual noise emissions due to the operation of the Facility. The Company shall:
 - a. carry out Acoustic Audit measurements in accordance with the procedures in Ministry Publication NPC-103; and
 - b. submit an Acoustic Audit Report on the results of the Acoustic Audit, prepared by an Independent Acoustical Consultant, in accordance with the requirements of Ministry Publication NPC-233, to the District Manager and the Director, not later than May 28, 2026.

and replaced with the following conditions:

13. ACOUSTIC AUDIT

1. The Company shall carry out Acoustic Audit measurements on the actual noise emissions due to the operation of the Facility. The Company shall:
 - a. carry out Acoustic Audit measurements in accordance with the procedures in Ministry Publication NPC-103; and
 - b. submit an Acoustic Audit Report on the results of the Acoustic Audit, prepared by an Independent Acoustical Consultant, in accordance with the requirements of Ministry Publication NPC-233, to the District Manager and the Director, not later than three (3) months from the date of this Notice.

All other Terms and Conditions remain the same.

The reasons for this amendment to the Approval are as follows:

Noise Controls have been installed for existing noise sensitive points of reception. Updated Acoustic Assessment Report dated March 12, 2026, has been submitted as per condition 12.

This Notice shall constitute part of the approval issued under Approval No. 0061-BT9KFE dated September 16, 2020

In accordance with Section 139 of the *Environmental Protection Act*, you may by written notice served upon me, the Ontario Land Tribunal and in accordance with Section 47 of the *Environmental Bill of Rights*, 1993, the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks, within 15 days after receipt of this notice, require a hearing by the Tribunal. The Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks will place notice of your appeal on the Environmental Registry. Section 142 of the *Environmental Protection Act* provides that the notice requiring the hearing ("the Notice") shall state:

- a. The portions of the environmental compliance approval or each term or condition in the environmental compliance

- approval in respect of which the hearing is required, and;
- b. The grounds on which you intend to rely at the hearing in relation to each portion appealed.

Pursuant to subsection 139(3) of the *Environmental Protection Act*, a hearing may not be required with respect to any terms and conditions in this environmental compliance approval, if the terms and conditions are substantially the same as those contained in an approval that is amended or revoked by this environmental compliance approval.

The Notice should also include:

1. The name of the appellant;
2. The address of the appellant;
3. The environmental compliance approval number;
4. The date of the environmental compliance approval;
5. The name of the Director, and;
6. The municipality or municipalities within which the project is to be engaged in.

And the Notice should be signed and dated by the appellant.

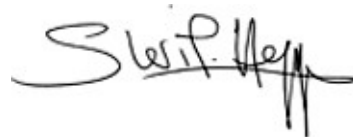
