Based on our review of the proposal to streamline permissions for water takings for construction site dewatering activities and foundation drains (ERO#019-6853), Stantec has the following comments to provide:

WATER TAKINGS

- Please clarify the following requirement provided under Applicable Requirements under O.Reg. 63/16 for Construction Site Dewatering
 - Specific criteria must be met when discharging water taken during the construction project:

 Any ground water or storm water discharged to land or a storm sewer that is within 30 metres of a water body shall ensure that the turbidity of the discharge does not exceed 8 Nephelometric Turbidity Units (NTU) above the background level of the nearest water body
