<p>The <i>GO Transit Station Funding Act, 2023</i> is amended to provide greater flexibility in determining when Transit Station Charges are to be paid for new residential developments (either at the time of permit issuance or at building occupancy).</p> <p>Amendment to the <i>Transit-Oriented Communities Act, 2020</i> to enable the establishment of a TOC Advisory Panel to help create a clear and effective dispute resolution framework.</p>	<p>It's difficult to determine the full implications of this change without a clear understanding of how the members of the TOC advisory panel will be established, as well as the extent of its powers in the decision-making process.</p>
