Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Environmental Compliance Approval (air) proposal for Da-Lee Services Inc. (ERO # 025-1314).

The Health Hazards and Vector-borne Diseases Program (“the Program”) exists within the Healthy Environments Division of Hamilton Public Health. The Program is mandated by the Province of Ontario’s Public Health Standards “*To reduce exposure to health hazards and promote the development of healthy built and natural environments that support health and mitigate existing and emerging risks, including the impacts of a changing climate.*”
